The program ended with a sumptuous dinner leaving behind cherished memories.


IBÂ ÂLUMNI ONLINE DÂTÂBÂSE FORM

In order to keep you connected to your alma mater, IBA Alumni office in collaboration with IT department launched an Alumni Online Database form on January 26, 2013. After almost two months of rigorous deliberation and painstaking technical work, the form was designed keeping in view the requirements of the Alumni. Throughout this period, we were guided by our very own Alumnus Mr. Shahid Shafiq who is also Alumni Representative on the IBA Board of Governors.

The main purpose of this form is to help IBA keep abreast of your career and personal development, assist in research, and allow you to participate in future alumni elections to the Board of Governors.

Keeping in view the privacy issues, the form is SSL certified which will keep your sensitive information sent across the Internet encrypted. All data will remain confidential, and released only after you allow IBA to do so.

The Form is intended for alumni already registered with IBA (Existing User), and also for those who are not yet a part of the IBA database (New User).

A user interface will appear before you select Existing User and New User. Just check the button next to Existing User, tick the Terms of Use and click Proceed. Use the email address on which you have received the notification and insert the password

It is very important that Existing Users carefully go through the present information, since your data may not be updated and/or, in some cases, erroneous. Please help IBA get a better view of your whereabouts. This will take just a few minutes, and is a one-time exercise, until your particulars change.

All those who have not received their username and password must contact the Alumni department alumni@ iba.edu.pk. This way you will only have to update your credentials and not make a new account. By making a New User account, you will have to wait for the verification process before being approved in our database. Moreover, the same username and password will be applicable for the upcoming Alumni website.

Please request all your IBA friends and colleagues to complete the Registration Form. In case they do not receive an email from the IBA, they can contact the IBA Alumni Department to obtain a password.

Otherwise, they can log on to the form using the New User button.

IBA is pleased to announce the launch of BS Social Science and Liberal Arts Program from Fall 2013.


