IBA feels a profound sense of sorrow at the sad demise of Dr.I.A. Mukhtar. He was the Institute's first Dean & Director. It was as a result of his vision and policies that the IBA grew to be an excellent business school in a

very short time. Dr.I.A. Mukhtar took his B.A (Hons) Degree in Economics from The Saint Stephen's College in Delhi and an MA Degree from the Muslim University in Aligarh, where he received the gold medal for his performance. In appreciation to the extraordinary contribution made by Dr. I.A. Mukhtar to the development and growth of the IBA, The Board of Governors of the IBA made him Professor Emeritus and also conferred upon him the Honorary Doctor of Laws (Honoris Causa). The President of Pakistan also conferred upon him, the Civil Award of Sitara-e-Imtiaz. His Contributions have made IBA the institution it is today.

The late Dr. Mukhtar is survived by his wife, three sons and two daughters. The "Baba-e-IBA" shall always be remembered.
